Agenda 4: Action Plan for the year 2016-17:

The Action Plan for the year 2016 was discussed under the following headings:

> Disbursement of Funds to 8500 Schools:

The Committee was informed that a letter was received from Ministry of Environment Forests & Climate Change, New Delhi, vide letter No. F.No.3-2/2016-EE (pt) dt. 26.10.2016 after we had already disbursed the funds. It was decided that Rashtriya Madhyamika Shikshana Abhiyana (RMSA) & Sarva Shikshana Abhiyana (SSA) will disburse the funds through Electronic Clearing Service to Deputy Director of Public Instruction and the schools and send a copy of ECS/RTGS statement to Environmental Management & Policy Research Institute (EMPRI).

It was also discussed that, Utilisation Certificates shall be

collected at various levels in the Education Department and finally consolidated Utilisation Certificate will be given to EMPRI by RMSA and SSA.

Visiting 40 Schools to review the activities of Eco Clubs:

The Committee deliberated on the issue and decided that a total number of 40 Schools have to be visited by EMPRI by the end of March 2017.

Training Eco-Club Teachers:

The subject was deliberated in detail and it was decided to conduct the training at EMPRI on 25th & 26th Nov. 2016. RMSA & SSA will choose the people who will be trained as master trainers and send a list to EMPRI. Two master Trainers shall be selected from each district. Also RMSA & SSA shall write and instruct these Master Trainers to visit EMPRI for training purpose. In turn EMPRI will prepare the training module and organize training for training these trainers.

The Education Department shall organize the training at Taluk level on 30th Nov. 2016, in coordination with EMPRI through SATCOM Training. This shall be followed by training of all the teachers/headmasters who are incharge of Eco clubs in 8500 educational institutes throughout Karnataka on 3rd Dec. 2016 by Education Department through SATCOM.

Attending a few DIMC Meetings:

Out of 34 Educational Districts, District Implementation & Monitoring Committees have not been formed in 13 districts. RMSA & SSA will instruct DDPIs to contact their Deputy Commissioner's so that DIMC can form early and they should also hold regular meetings.
