#### A. Disbursement of Fund

Ministry of Environment, Forest and climate change sanctioned Rs.9,44,35,000/-(Rupees nine crore forty four lakh and thirty five thousand only) and released Rs.9,29,99,112/-(Rupees nine crore twenty nine lakh ninety nine thousand and one hundred and twelve only) for the FY 2020-21 as given below

Rs 71,49,112/- Administrative charges for the FY 2019-20 (10% of total releases to Eco-clubs and district level monitoring) has been released in the FY 2020-21.

Rs 85,85,000/- Administrative charges for the FY 2020-21 (10% of total releases to Eco-clubs and district level monitoring) will be reimbursed during FY 2021-22.

The Committee deliberated on the matter and authorised Director General, EMPRI to implement the scheme as per the guidelines of Government of India.

#### B. Swachhta Action Plan Scheme

EMPRI has received Sanction order from MoEF&CC for Rs 20,00,000 vide letter No:F.NO.3-13/2019-SSB dated 22-06-2020 in response to the proposal submitted by EMPRI.

#### **NGC Activities & Swachhta Action Plan(SAP) Activities**

After detailed deliberation the committee suggested following;


- To promote the programme as joint collaborative programme of Environmental Management and Policy Research Institute (EMPRI), Education Department and Government of India and to use logo of Education department along with EMPRI logo in all programme/activities of NGC.
- To involve NSS volunteers of pre university colleges in online activities and conduct inspiring online programmes due to covid -19 situation.
- To create awareness of the programme & activities to be implemented by District Implementation and Monitoring Committee (DIMC) at district level to utilise fund of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees twenty five thousand only).
- To create awareness of the programme & activities to be implemented by Eco club schools to utilise fund of Rs.5,000/- (Rupees five thousand only).
- To create awareness among students to take up activities which focus on cleanliness of home, village and their city or place they live as schools are closed due to COVID-19.
- To create awareness among students to take up environmental activities while maintaining social distancing due to COVID-19.
- Students to take up awareness activities regarding COVID-19 & other infectious diseases.



- Committee suggested EMPRI to coordinate with different Environmental Organisation to implement NGC activities.
- Suggested to create dashboard in NGC website.
- Suggested to assess the eco-club schools by preparing standard parameters and recognise best eco-clubs, best eco-club in-charge teachers and reward them as it will encourage them and inspire others.


